



Frequently Asked Questions

Everything you need to know about the photos and visiting Santa:

Should I reserve my child's place to take a photo with Santa?

We strongly recommend that you do. We do buy little gifts for everyone so it helps us ensure we buy enough.

Can I come with children that do not have autism?

Yes, of course! All children are welcome.

Can my other children visit Santa at the same time as my child with ASD?

Certainly! Family photos with Santa are a possibility. Individual photos for all are available.

Is the photo session sensory friendly?

Yes

Can I take photos of my child(ren) with Santa with my own phone or camera?

No, no photos are allowed.

Are there fees for taking a photo with Santa?

Yes. A photo with Santa is 10\$ per print. All photos are in color and come in a Holiday folder.

How many pictures can I get with Santa?

As many as you like! Every print is 10\$.

Can my child visit Santa without taking a photo?

Yes.

If my child is receiving a FDMT gift, do I still need to pay for a photo with Santa?

Yes.

***Everything you need to know about
Receiving a gift:***

If I come unexpectedly, will my child be able to receive a free FDMT gift, even if I show proof of a diagnosis?

Unfortunately, not. These gifts are pre-ordered, therefore there are no extras.



Will all my children get a free FDMT gift of my choice?

The only children receiving a free gift from FDMT are those that are registered and have shown proof of an Autism Spectrum Diagnosis.

Will children without a diagnosis receive something from Santa too?

Yes. There will be a gift given to all kids by Santa (usually a puzzle or coloring set)

Can I bring my own gift for Santa to give to my other children?

Yes. Simply notify us when you come in.

Can I purchase an FDMT gift from your list for my other children?

Does my child need to be present to receive his/her FDMT gift?

Yes.

If I cannot make it to the event, can my child's gift be shipped to me or will it be available for pick up?

No.

The party:

Will there be food and beverages at the party?

Yes.

Is there a fee for food and beverages?

Yes, there is a very minimal fee. Usually 0.25\$ to 2.00\$

Is the party sensory friendly?

Unfortunately, we cannot control for that in a party setting. There will be a quiet play area for the kids that might find the party a little overwhelming.

Will there be activities for the children?

Yes, there will be a bouncy castle and different activity stations (more information to follow).

Will there be people there to look after my children?

Although volunteers will be present throughout the day assisting with festivities, YOU are still responsible for looking after your children.

Are boots allowed in the party room?

In the event of rain or snow, wet footwear will not be allowed in the room.
